- 1. The advisory committee consists of various educational professionals and laboratory professionals that provide valuable input to program operations.
- 2. Members will serve an open term.
- 3. A list of advisory committee members is available upon request.

Meetings

1. The advisory committee will meet once a year or more often as necessary.
